which aspire to higher erudition in the encyclopedia of biblical literature the initials of the writers are annexed to their respective contributions this has not been deemed necessary in the present abridgment but a list is given of all the writers who cooperated with the editor in the production of the original work from which the present compendium has been formed many articles in the larger encyclopedia more especially in the department of natural history are treated under the hebrew or greek form of a word but in the present popular compendium it has been judged better that these articles should appear under the names by which they are represented in the authorized version of the scriptures and take their place in the alphabetical position they hold under these names it remains only to be added that although the editor has taken some part of the labor and has supervised the whole operation the substantial work of the abridgment has been executed by the careful hands of the reverend james taylor d d of glasgow
